My bishop provides the vision and direction for the diocese's life and trusts me to bring it to reality through guidance and collaboration. I help bring the diocesan vision to life by aligning daily operations, mission strategy, and pastoral care with shared goals and objectives. I support collaboration across diocesan staff, governance, parish leaders, volunteers, and ministry partners from the global Anglican Communion, the wider Church, and local communities.

Leadership and Vision:

- Worked with the Bishop to restructure staff, reducing full-time positions from 28 to 13 and creating
 five new roles tailored to better serve parishes. This restructuring prioritized efficiency and realigned
 resources to meet parish needs.
- Partnered with budget committees to shift focus toward parish vitality, reducing administrative costs to under 50% of the \$6.5M annual budget and limiting payroll to a third of overall expenses. These changes made room for increased support for local ministry and programs.
- Led a diocesan team in reopening three closed parishes, growing the combined Average Sunday Attendance (ASA) from 0 to 256 by fostering community engagement and shared local leadership.

Governance and Financial Oversight:

- Helped maintain steady diocesan spending while increasing benefits to parishes and encouraging deeper engagement.
- Supported collaborative oversight of seven diocesan campuses and six vicars.
- Facilitated annual budgeting in consultation with governance bodies and parishes, advising on financial strategy and stewardship.
- Worked with the finance office and trustees to align endowment spending with diocesan priorities.

Preaching and Pastoral Engagement:

- Preached and led worship in most of the diocese's 136 congregations, offering support in times of transition and pastoral care during clergy absences or crises.
- Known for preaching that is joyful, thoughtful, and rooted in real life.

Crisis Leadership:

- Partnered with diocesan and parish leaders to establish COVID-19 protocols that kept communities safe and spiritually connected.
- Worked with lay and clergy leadership to guide parishes through post-COVID recovery with the "Casting Nets" initiative, a step-by-step guide for parish revitalization to ensure parishes remain relevant going into the next century.
